Sole proprietors must submit a cover page for Form 1,040 with a Schedule C or a Schedule F and a Schedule SE as proof of sole proprietors for the sole of fore "are not eligible to participate in the SOCA Benefit Plan. Final participation and premium equivalent rates must be approved by Underwriting and the SOCA Benefit Plan.
